Supernatural Virtue of Hope

This column is a newsletter regular feature, from the book "MY DAILY BREAD". (by Rev. Anthony J. Paone, S.J. 1954).

CHRIST MIGHT SAY:

y child, one of the most wonderful virtues in your soul is the virtue of hope. I placed it there as a tiny seed at your baptism. It was to grow and help you through life's trials and difficulties. This is the virtue which makes you desire Me as the Highest Good. It inspires you to look forward to Heaven's unending joys, and confidently expect from Me whatever help is needed to gain eternal life. This virtue calms all fears and worries about your salvation. It helps you look to My power, see My goodness, and rely upon My love. It makes you firm and confident when doubts and difficulties tempt you to turn away from Me in despair. Supernatural hope makes you expect My help in your daily efforts to live a good life. This heavenly gift of hope, however, is incomplete without your sincere daily effort to fulfill My Will in your daily life. He who expects to gain eternal happiness without doing his part, is guilty of the sin of presumption. Hope makes your prayers more effective. I cannot refuse one who firmly and confidently expects My assistance in his real needs. The man of hope wants only what is really necessary for his final success. Even when he prays for an earthly favor, he wants it only if it will improve him or the person for whom he prayers. The perfection of this virtue is a complete self surrender to My wisdom in all matters. The supernatural virtue of hope gives vision to the mind, strength to the will, courage to the heart, and endurance to the body. It makes one sure of victory because he relies upon Me, the all knowing, all powerful, all loving God. This wonderful virtue brings a sense of security to the soul. Work out your salvation in hope and fear not, for I shall never fail you.

THINK:

It Paul says that "We are saved by hope." How true! With such a virtue in my soul, how can I be lost? I will turn to God with a firm confidence. I will place my life in His hands by embracing all of His commandments, and by fulfilling His Will, even when it is disagreeable or difficult. God will not be outdone in generosity. He will supply whatever strength is necessary for this. Once I develop this holy virtue of hope within me, I shall know at last what it means to be free of fears and doubts. I shall then possess the peace of God

PRAY:

God of love, all powerful and all wise, I turn to You today in hope. I want to be Yours, as You Yourself want me to be. Let me prove my sincerity

by doing whatever is necessary to obtain this holy favor. You want to give me the supernatural strength to become ever more perfect in my daily life. You will never deny me whatever is truly necessary for my highest success. I desire to begin at last to live a life of loyalty to Your wonderful plan. If I look toward Heaven in my daily activities, many things will become easier. Sadness, discouragement, fear, and despair will never torment me. Lord, show me the way. I long to follow Your holy Will, along this road to peace and heavenly glory. True, You may lead me along rough paths at times, but I must not forget that my final destination is well worth the trouble. Amen.

Over 201,000 Rosaries distributed!

Although we have been distributing rosaries on and off to the men in prison for a long time, at times, we are NOT permitted to do so.

Therefore, any rosaries sent to us, will be distributed to other ministries and activities (street ministry, abortion clinics, etc). We are very thankful to everyone who has sent us (and still does)

To date, we've distributed 201,070 Rosaries!

Praying God's Purposes ...For YOUR City...

(from the book of the same name by Ernie Frederick) n most cities God has given prophetic words of His purposes for the city. Sometimes these prophecies are given in citywide conferences, sometimes in local churches. Some may have been given in decades past, some in more current contexts. What does a city, 'possessed for God's purposes' "look like" in concrete terms? As you pray God's purposes for your city, here are some 'visions of hope' snapshots of what God could work to "let His Kingdom come and His will be done" in the life and activities of your city and its communities. Let's pray with vision of hope for God's promised supernatural transforming workings in these areas/ways: Praying Groups... to see incense (prayers of

supplication) and pure offerings (of thanks and praise) springing up in many places throughout your city. (Malachi 1:11, Psalm 113:3)

Prayer Driving Commuters...to see people of your city prayer driving into the city and in their communities from the north, south, east, and west, with 'soaking' praise, blessings, supplications and welcoming God's Presence in the city.

Families... to see families giving priority each day to gather in prayer for one another, for their community, for their workplace and school (Psalm 5:3)

Community Pray-ers... to see gathering of prayer for neighborhood and community leaders to let the government be on God's shoulders, guided by His wonderful counsel, mighty power, never ending Fatherhood, shalom of the Prince of Peace, in the plans and policies of government (Isaiah 9:6-7)

Courts... to see courthouse pray-ers seeking God to fill courts with the Spirit of Truth, to rule the court cases (John 16:13)

Workplace Praying... to see workers entering their workplaces with thanksgiving and their work areas with praise (Ps 100:4)

Business Meetings... to see company meetings opened with prayer for God's guidance for the agenda (Luke 11:9-10)

Malls... to see malls opened for business each day with loud speakers prayers for workers and for customers (John 16:24)

Hospitals... to see hospital staff briefings include prayer for doctors, nurses, aids, patients and their families (James 1:5) Taxis and Buses... to see drivers blessing their customers for a good day's activities as they drive them (Psalm 125:15)

Restaurants... to see restaurant workers welcoming the Presence of God to 'fill the place' as people come to dine (Luke 125:15)

Sporting Events... to see players and coaches gather to pray for God's guidance and strength for the contest (Colossians 1:9)


