

"Pray as you travel" can be a means of "soaking the city" by sending Waves of Prayer" before you as you drive in cars, buses, trolley, subways, taxis, jitneys into the city, and as you walk to your workplace, mall, store, church, restaurant, service station, bank, hair dresser or barber shop, or other appointments. Here are some suggestions to enrich your city with WAVES of Prayer as you travel into the city to do your activities:

Saturating the City with PRAISE... singing "All Hail the Power of Jesus Name" over the city and 'Crowning Him, Lord of the Government, of the polices, courts, schools, hospitals, businesses, banks, restaurants", Praising Him for His owner provision for the city for His righteous Kingship role over the city, His Fathers protection around the city, for His Shepherd's care in the

city.

Blessing the City with God's Goodness...singing 'God is SO GOOD" over the city, good to families, good to the doctors and nurses, good to the teachers, good to radio and TV leaders, restaurant workers. Blessings the neighborhoods of the city with God's peace, the churches with God's grace and favor, the sick, homeless, unemployed with God's care.

Welcoming God's PRESENCE and WORKING in the city... welcoming the Presence and working of God the FATHER... Father we welcome You in the schools of the city today, to care for every child, teacher and administrator.. the presence and working of the SON.. Jesus we welcome You today in the restaurants of the city to build harmony and friendships among those who prepare and serve the food, and those who eat there... The presence and working of the HOLY SPIRIT, we welcome YOU in the TV and Radio stations to pour forth Your love, joy, peace, wisdom, care to all.

Praying Supplications/prayers for God's help for the city... Lord, Our Mayor and City council Need YOUR wisdom, our judges and attorneys need YOUR truth and justice, the construction workers need YOUR skills and safety, our doctors and nurses need YOUR healing power with them and MANY NEED salvation. #### **CHRIST MIGHT SAY:**

on, all men must have some friend in whom they can place their confidence and trust. Without such a friend you cannot live happily. The more that friend means to you, the greater will be the happiness which he brings you. What human friend can ever mean as much to you as I do? Who thinks of you as much as I do? Consider how much I have done for you, and you will easily understand that I am your truest friend. To neglect Me is to neglect Him Whom you need most and Who lives you most. When you trust in humans without considering My place in your life, you are building on sand. All intelligence, strength, and every good thing are My gifts. Without these gifts you are nothing, and your life is a wasted effort. Your human friends can fail you, at least by their inability to help you in all things. Their judgments can be quite mistaken, and they can lead you astray even when they wish to help you. You will find perfect and unfailing friendship only in Me, and in My angels and saints. Let your greatest trust and confidence be in Me at all times.

#### THINK:

I umans are so often fooled by appearances. Some people are impressed only by visible results. Their praise is worthless because they fail to see the inner goodness of others. Or again they do not realize how brief are the trials and joys of this present life. Am I that shallow or do I try to follow God's way of thinking? Is my trust in Him shaken by the judgments of worldly minded people? It is never God Who lets me down, but it is I who fail Him. I refuse to trust in Him completely by letting Him govern my daily life as He wishes. # Over 201,000 Rosaries distributed!

To date, we've distributed 201,495 Rosaries!

#### Take up YOGA!

ike meditation, yoga is an extremely popular and effective method for becoming a more relaxed, easy going person. For centuries, yoga has been used to clear and free the mind, giving people feelings of ease and equanimity. It's easy to do and takes only a few minutes a day. What's more, people of virtually any age and fitness level can participate. I once took a class at the health club that included both a ten year old boy and an 87 year old man. Yoga is noncompetitive in nature. You work and progress at your own speed and comfort level. Although yoga is physical in nature, its benefits are both physical and emotional. On the physical side, yoga strengthens the muscles and the spine, creating flexibility and ease of motion. On the emotional side, yoga is a tremendous stress reducer. It balances the body/mind/spirit connection, giving you a feeling of ease and peace. Yoga is practiced by engaging in a series of stretches, both gentle and challenging. The stretches are designed to open the body and lengthen the spine, the stretches focus on very specific, usually tight and constricted places, the neck, back, hips, legs, and spine. While you are stretching, you are also concentrating, focusing your attention on what you are doing. The effects of yoga are truly amazing. After only a few minutes, you feel more alive and open, peaceful and relaxed. Your mind is clear, the rest of your day is easier and more focused. I used to believe that I was too busy to practice yoga. I felt I didn't have time. I'm now certain that the opposite is true, I don't have time not to practice yoga. It's too important not to do. It keep s me feeling young and energized. It's also a wonderful and peaceful way to spend time with family and/or friends. Rather than watching television together, my two daughters and I often flip on a yoga video and spend a few minutes stretching together. Like meditation, it's easy to find a local class at a community center, the YMCA, or health club. If you prefer to learn from a book, my favorite is Richard Hittleman's YOGA 28 day exercise plan. There are also many fine videos you can learn from as well as a magazine dedicated solely to yoga called Yoga Journal.
