

# The Virtue of Charity

#### **CHRIST MIGHT SAY:**

y Child, at y our baptism I placed the virtue of charity in your soul, expecting you to -develop it after you had reached the age of reason. This is the virtue which causes you to love Me above all things for My own sake. It also enables you to love others for My sake. This virtue is your highest perfection. There is no greater achievement in human life than to love Me, the Supreme Good. No natural love can compare with the supernatural love of charity. Charity loves what is best, and it loves for the highest reason. The man of charity loved Me above all else because I am the Highest Good. Charity makes a man more God-like. You read in Scripture that "God is Love." By charity you become like Me, loving all that is right and good. Charity is the perfection of all other love. It reaches out to My perfect goodness and places Me first among its preferences. Even in his love for created things, the man of charity seeks them because they help him come closer to Me in daily life. He no longer accepts any person, or thing according to his likes and dislikes, but according to their goodness; that is, according to their ability to draw his thoughts and desires more firmly toward Me. He prefers those persons and things which help him please Me most. Develop this holy virtue in your daily life. Do it firstly by keeping My commandments secondly by honoring Me frequently in private prayers, and acts of public worship, thirdly by dealing unselfishly with people for My sake. True, you have to protect yourself against the selfishness and bad will of people on earth, but in so doing beware of being bitter, inconsiderate, or unjust toward them. For My sake wish everyone will, and as far as you are able, help those in need. In this way you will prove that you possess genuine charity in your soul.

### THINK:

As I reached the age of reason and learned of God's holy gift, I was expected to develop it by a continual effort to use it. My efforts plus God's further graces make the seed of charity grow within me. How have I used this precious gift? Without charity all other virtues lose their supernatural value. This means that I cannot gain Heaven until I have learned to practice charity in my daily life. As I advance in this virtue I become more like God, thinking and acting more and more like Him. I must begin today living as Jesus would live this life of mine. In spite of many failures, I must go on trying.

### PRAY:

You want me to reflect Your perfection in my daily thoughts, words, and actions. May I begin at long last to be a reflection of You love in everything I think, say and do. I desire to be patient, kind, thoughtful, helpful, and long-suffering, just as You have been with me, a sinner. In spite of selfish nature, I want to love You as You deserve. In all things let me never forget Your wisdom and goodness, so that I may always consider and follow what pleases you. My model in all this is Jesus, Your Divine Son. He is the model of perfect charity. Let me strive each day to become more like Him and less like myself. Amen.

### Do a Favor

### and don't ask for, or expect one, in Return!

his is a strategy that can help you practice integrating service into your life. It will s how you how easy it is and how good it feels to do something nice for someone without expecting anything in return. So often, either consciously or unconsciously, we want something from others, especially when we have done something for them, "I cleaned the bathroom, she should clean the kitchen." Or "I took care of her child last week, she should offer this week." It's almost as thought we keep score of our own good deeds rather than remembering that giving is its own reward.

When you do something nice for someone, just to do it, you'll notice (if you're quiet enough inside yourself) a beautiful feeling of ease and peace. Just as vigorous exercise releases endorphins in your brain that makes you feel good physically, your acts of loving kindness release the emotional equivalent. Your reward is the feeling you receive in knowing that you participated in an act of kindness. You don't need something in return or even a 'thank you', in fact, you don't even need to let the person know what you have done.

What interferes with this peaceful feeling is our expectation of reciprocity. Our own thoughts interfere with our peaceful feelings as they clutter our minds, as we get caught up in what we think we want or need. The solution is to notice your "I wasn't something in return" thoughts and gently dismiss them. In the absence of these thoughts, your positive feelings will return.

See if you can think of something really thoughtful to do for someone, and don't expect anything in return, whether it's surprising your spouse with a clean garage or organized desk, to give your spouse a break from the kids. When you complete your favor, see if you can tap into the warm feeling of knowing you have done something really nice without expecting anything from the person you have just helped. If you practice, I think you'll discover that the feelings themselves are reward enough.

Do you receive in the mail various medals, crosses, holy cards, etc. from missionary groups and other religious organizations, and don't really know what to do with them? If so, consider becoming a parish representative to 'collect these items' from other parishioners and sending them occasionally to us for use in our street ministry. The youth are always grateful to have these small tokens of faith and hope. Back in November 2013 when we thought we might have to move, we sought out 'more' monthly benefactors. # Praying God's Purposes For your City © Praying for Salvation of your city

(from the book of the same name by Ernie Frederick)

od wants your city to be saved, and your city
needs to be saved! God's purposes are clearly
stated in 1<sup>st</sup> Timothy 2:1-4, "First of all I urge
that supplications, prayers, intercessions and
thanksgivings be made for ALL PEOPLE... this is good
and is acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who
desired ALL PEOPLE to be saved and come to the
knowledge of the truth." Our prayers saturate the city
with seeds of God's Word and the soaking of the holy
Spirit, who germinated and grows these seeds of God's
will into the plantings of His pleasure. As you pray then
for the Salvation of your city, pray for:

A Salvation soaking of God's preparation... to bless people with a hunger and thirst for righteousness, to magnify the emptiness of sinful self-serving in their lives, to arouse a curiosity for a genuine relationship with God, to convince them of sin, righteousness and judgment, to birth a desperation of NEED for God within them, and to generate authentic heart-life repentance for sin.

A Salvation soaking of God's revelation... praying that God reveal HIS passion for personal intimacy with everyone of His creatures (John 3:16), that the seeking, saving g race of Jesus for lost persons like Zaccheus be unveiled (Luke 19:10), praying that Jesus be identified as the "friend of sinners", praying that God's salvation opportunity and His kingship timing to repent and believe be revealed (Mark 1:15) that Jesus' call be clear that

'whoever wants to follow Him, let him deny himself, take up his cross" (mark 8:34), that a gift of faith to trust God be given (Eph 2:8) and praying that the saving power of God be imparted (Rom 1:16)

A Salvation soaking of God's purposes... Praying that persons be saved into God's family (John 1:12), be saved into sonship at heirs (Gal 4:5), become friends with Jesus (Rev 3:20), become crucified with Christ (Gal 2:20), become worshippers of God (John 4:23), become salt and light disciples (Mt 5:13), become witness of Jesus (Acts 1:8), be ambassadors for Christ (II Cor. 5:20).

Be sure to pray for people in your family and neighborhood to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth.

# Almost 202,000 Rosaries distributed!

Although we have been distributing rosaries on and off to the men in prison for a long time, at times, we are NOT permitted to do so, Therefore, any rosaries sent to us, will be distributed to other ministries and activities (street ministry, abortion clinics, etc). We are very thankful to everyone who has sent us (and still does)

To date, we've distributed 201,745 Rosaries!
